Exam Basics

Conducted by	National Testing Agency (NTA)
Exam mode	Computer-Based Test (CBT) only, single shift for all subjects - no score normalisation needed
Total subjects offered	37 (13 languages, 23 domain-specific subjects, 1 General Test)
Subjects you may choose	Minimum 3, maximum 5
Duration per subject	60 minutes
Questions per subject	50 questions, all compulsory (no internal choice)
Marking scheme	+5 for a correct answer, -1 for an incorrect answer, 0 for unattempted

Typical Timeline (Based on Recent Cycles)

Registration opens	Tentatively early January (exact 2027 dates via the official info bulletin)
Exam window	Tentatively May-June 2027
Result declaration	Typically 4-6 weeks after the exam window closes

Who Accepts CUET Scores

Central universities	48 central universities require CUET UG scores for admission
Total participating universities	230+ as of the most recent cycle, expected to cross 300+ for 2027
